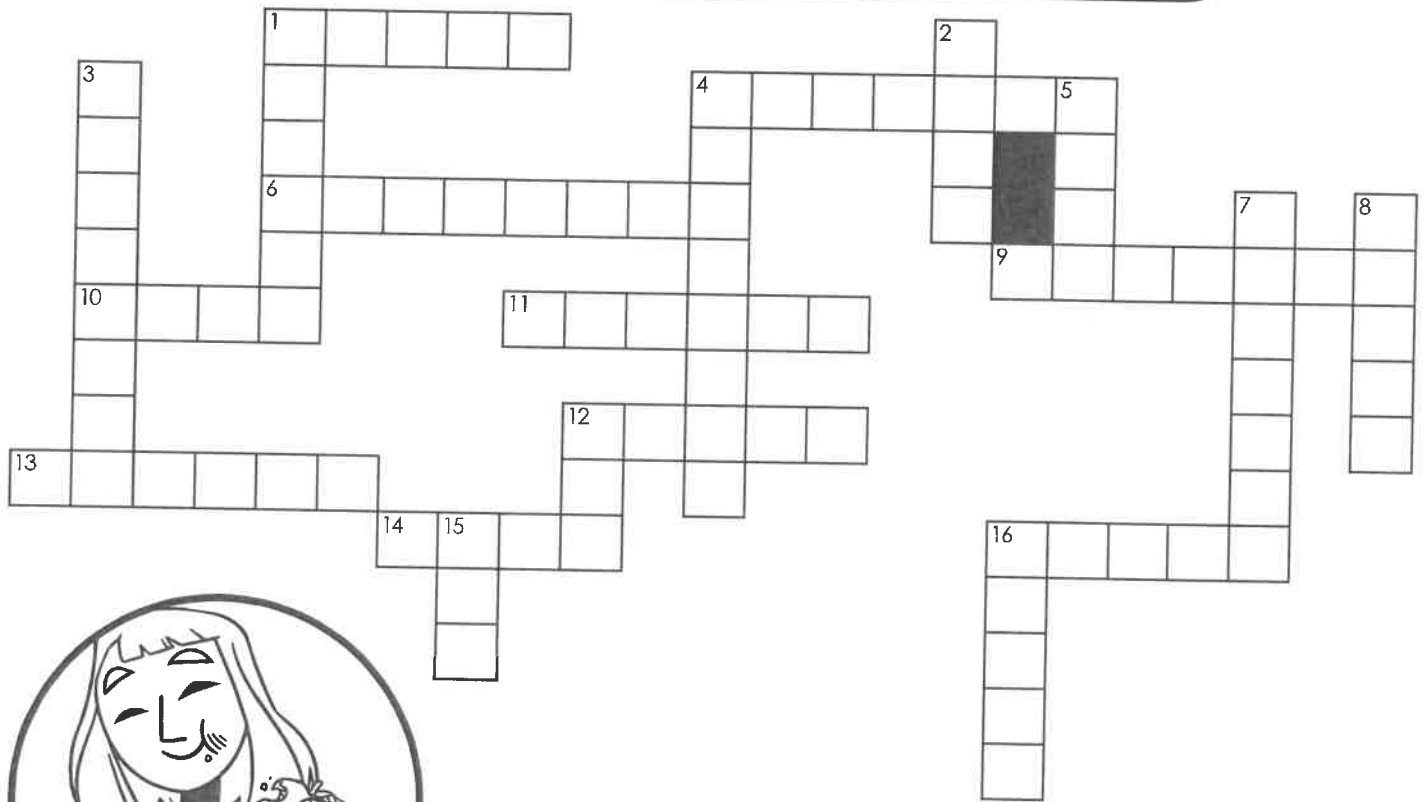

Poetry

- cultural stories that are passed down through generations, such as folktales and myths

Historical Fiction

- a type of fantasy that weaves science and technology into its story

Science Fiction

- texts that provide facts about various topics

Biography

- stories that could have actually occurred in a believable setting

Traditional Literature

- the story of a person's life, written by that person

Mystery

- the story of a person's life, written by another person

Fantasy

- a piece of writing that often has imagery, rhythm and rhyme
