Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

This year the Arkansas Department of Education is allowing Little Rock School District (LRSD) to participate in Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) on inclement weather days or "Snow Days." This means that on "Snow Days," students must complete one day's worth of assignments for each day school is closed due to snow or ice.

Assignments in this packet are labeled "Day 1," "Day 2," and so on and so forth. When students return to school, they must return their completed work to their teachers, and they will be counted present for school on the missed "Snow Day(s)." Therefore, missed days will not have to be made up at the end of the school year, but a high percentage of student participation is required.

Please put this packet in a safe place and complete when we have a "snow day". It will be the family's responsibility to Keep up with all assignments to complete. When there is snow or ice in the weather forecast, you must wait for LRSD to announce that schools will be closed via district website and local news and radio stations. Teachers will be available by email to assist their students as needed.
